

RULES

Rules & Regulations

1. The show organisers reserve the right to cancel, add to or amend any of the competitions as they see fit, with the approval of the British Showjumping office.
2. All classes listed in this schedule will be judged in accordance with the current British Showjumping rule book and the affiliated classes are confined to horses and ponies registered with the British Showjumping and must be owned and ridden by members in accordance with Rule 79.
3. Some prizes may be withheld under rule 76.6.
4. If any person lodges an objection, such an objection should be made in writing and a £100 deposit paid (Rule 198), to the Secretary within half an hour of the incident. The deposit will be refunded if the objection is sustained.
5. The organisers and land owners will not be held responsible for any incident or injury to riders, owners, spectators or any person or property whatsoever, however caused. It is a condition of entry that each entrant shall agree to indemnify the promoters against any legal action arising from such incident.
6. No members shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owners, lessee, authorised agent or rider, to compete or be prepared to compete, in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at risk or injury – Rule 82.21. Stallions are not allowed to compete on the "Ticket to Ride" scheme.
7. The decision of the Judge is final.
8. There will be a £4 surcharge for Paramedic cover per rider per day.
9. DOGS: Must be on a leash.
10. Rule 164.1a will be applied (45 second Count Down will be in operation).
11. All competitors will be required to have their current membership numbers when entering.
